Dr. Samir K. Sinha, MD, DPhil, FRCPC, AGSF

We are thrilled to welcome Dr. Samir Sinha, one of Canada's foremost health policy specialists, a highly regarded Toronto clinician and an international expert on the care of older adults, to keynote the 30th Anniversary Toronto Planning Dinner. Dr. Sinha will share important, emerging and inspiring lessons about the intersection between health outcomes as we age and how our communities are planned in a post-pandemic society.

This year's Dinner, occurring on World Town Planning Day and marking our post-pandemic re-emergence, is a momentous event with a particularly timely Keynote and topic. In addition to architecting Ontario's Seniors Strategy, Dr. Sinha has helped the City of Toronto develop and implement two Seniors Strategies as Co-Chair of the Seniors Strategy Accountability Table; work which resulted in World Health Organization recognition of Toronto as Canada's largest Age-Friendly City. He has also been named by MacLean's as one of Canada's 50 most influential people and its most compelling voice for the elderly. He is a frequent panelist on TVO's The Agenda and is consulted regularly by and on major news outlets and programs, including CBC, the Globe and Mail and Toronto Star.

Dr. Sinha is the Director of Geriatrics at Sinai Health System and the University Health Network in Toronto, a Professor of Medicine at the University of Toronto and the Director of Health Policy Research at Toronto Metropolitan University's National Institute on Ageing as well as a Rhodes Scholar. He is a member of Canada's National Seniors Council and is also leading the development of

new National Long-Term Care Standards for Canada. Internationally, Dr. Sinha is a Fellow of the American Geriatrics Society and a member of the American Red Cross Scientific Advisory Council and has consulted and advised hospitals and health authorities in Britain, China, Iceland, Singapore, St. Kitts and Nevis, Taiwan and the United States.
